Dear Artist,

We hope you'll be joining us for this year's show, featuring the artwork of Waynesboro artist Katie Garner. As in past years, there is no charge to participate, but a 15% commission will be deducted from all sales to help with set-up, reception and advertising costs. This is a change from the 10% charged in previous years and is necessary to cover the increasing costs associated with holding the event.

Another change to this year's show is the introduction of a system to jury the exhibits. As previous attendees will be aware, space (or lack thereof) is an issue at our current location. Although we are looking at expanding to a second downtown location, this has not been finalized for this year's show. We believe that by jurying the show, we can offer a broader range of work as well as control the space in a fairer manner. Linked to this is the requirement that all artists confirm their participation by completing and returning the attached form.

For the jury, we ask that artists submit photographs of 3 pieces of their work ***no later than Monday October 6th***. These need only be representative of your work, not necessarily the artwork you will be displaying. If you plan on entering a variety of media (e.g. jewelry and pottery), be sure to submit a photo for each *type* of media. However, if you maintain a website with current photographs, you may provide the jury with your web address instead of photos. You may email digital photographs to [Arts@LibertySquare.org](mailto:Arts@LibertySquare.org) or mail prints to **205 W 7<sup>th</sup> Street, Waynesboro, GA.**

The only exceptions to this requirement are artists affiliated with local educational groups, schools or art co-operatives. Artists who are members of the Clay Potters of the Southeast, Burke County High School art program or art classes through Katie Garner will not be juried. Each group will be given an allotted space, and the organizer of each group will make his/her selections.

Artists will be informed of the jury's decision by letter or email the following week. However you choose to submit the photographs, ***we still require a completed application form.*** This will help us plan the layout and placement of the displays.

As in previous years and to keep the exhibit fresh, we ask that you keep previously shown and "display only" works to a minimum.

If you have your own website, we will be happy to place a link on our Liberty Art site. Also, if you have any digital images of your work that you would like posted, please forward them to ***Arts@LibertySquare.org.*** Some of these images may also be used in newspaper advertisements for the show.

Additional information about times/set-up will be mailed to all registered artists.
