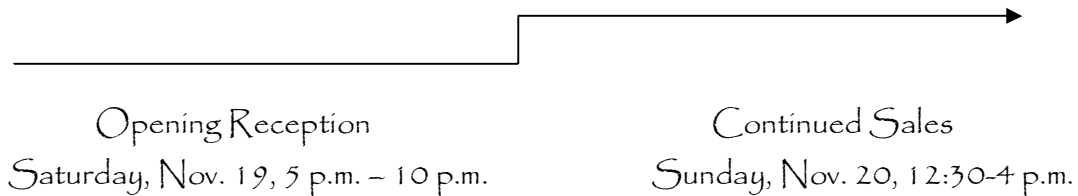

Dear Artist,

Following the success last year with our Bird Dog Statue Auction, we are continuing this year with the sale of more dogs. Again, we will be teaming up with Waynesboro's **Downtown Organization Of Retailers** (D.O.O.R.), seeking local and regional artists interested in becoming part of this venture and a part of downtown Waynesboro's art history.

Here's our plan:

These life-size concrete bird dog statues are to be decorated by selected artists then auctioned on opening night of ***Liberty Art, 2011*** (*Saturday November 19nd*) in conjunction with the traditional art show you are all familiar with. Our plan is to display the dogs in prominent downtown locations prior to the show and may remain downtown outside Waynesboro businesses on a semi-permanent basis, depending on the wishes of the winning bidder.

Artists will be asked to personalize their dog sculptures to an original theme and give the dog a name appropriate to that theme. Rough sketches or written descriptions, with details about your ideas and materials you plan to use, are requested to help in the selection process. Originality will play a large role when our volunteer art jury selects its 5 favorites.

While any medium is acceptable, please keep in mind that the dogs will likely be displayed outdoors.

The statues will be available for collection by contacting **Mike** at **706-534-1427** or **Arts@LibertySquare.org** or **Nan** and **Amy** at **706-554-8100** to arrange a time.

To offset the cost of supplies, each artist will receive 15% commission from the winning bid on his or her finished statue (*a restriction set by the IRS, not us*).

The Rest of the Show

In conjunction with the dog venture we will have our regular Art Show. Due to space limitations, we will restrict the number of participants. All applicants will be juried, so a photograph of a typical piece of work is requested (*this can be emailed to Arts@LibertySquare.org*).

Once again, due to tax liabilities, we ask artists to handle their own sales. Instead of deducting a 15% commission as in the past, we will be charge each artist a flat \$25 fee.

Event setup will be Friday November 18th from 8am to 8pm and Saturday 19th November from 8am to 12pm; tear-down will be after Sunday's show and Monday morning from 8am to 12pm, no exceptions.

If you are interested in the bird dog project or art show, please complete the included forms and return A.S.A.P.

Entries for the bird dog statues will not be considered after October 2nd and entries for the Art Show will not be considered after October 9th.

We hope you will join us in helping to support the promotion of our community and the longevity of the Liberty Art Show
